Private Autism/ADHD Assessment Clinics - Essex

Assessments for autism and ADHD are offered under the NHS for all ages, however some people may choose to explore a private assessment for a variety of reasons. The contacts on this information sheet are *not* recommended or endorsed by SNAP but aim to give families a starting point for their own research. When considering a private assessment there are some important things to discuss or consider.

- What is the occupation and the qualifications of the person(s) carrying out the assessment?
- Does the clinic follow the NICE guidelines for assessment?
- What are the *full* costs involved?
- What type of assessment tool(s) do they use?
- What do they offer following the assessment and what will be included in any reports?
- If you are seeking an ADHD assessment and considering medication options following a diagnosis, is this something the clinic can provide and what costs are involved? Please bear in mind the NHS may not take on a private prescription.
- Is the clinic also commissioned by the NHS to do assessments?
- Are they able to refer onto therapy services if required e.g. Speech and Language or Occupational Therapy?


